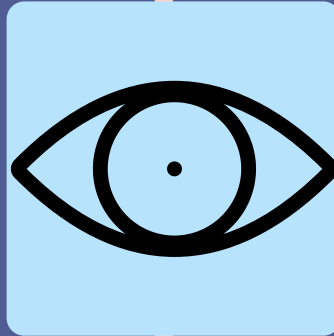


SIGNS OF AN OPIOID OVERDOSE

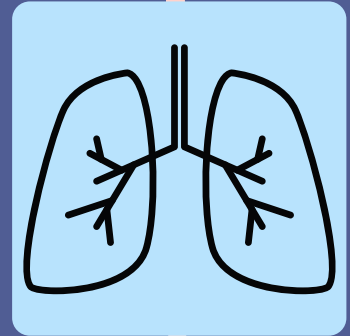
Unconscious and unresponsive



Very small pupils



Slow or Shallow Breathing



Vomiting



Pale, clammy Face



Slow, irregular or weak pulse



Body is limp



Fingernails and lips change color



Choking or snoring sounds



AN OVERDOSE IS NOT A DEATH SENTENCE



Recovery Position

If you notice someone overdosing :
Try to wake them up and keep them awake
Call 911
If available, administer Naloxone (Narcan)
Put them in the recovery position
stay until help arrives
